OV-1 “Mohawk”

A fast, armed reconnaissance and attack aircraft used for battlefield surveillance and close air support, equipped with rockets and electronic sensors.



L-19D/O-1D “Bird Dog”

Our Vietnam-era “Bird Dog” forward air control aircraft is used for controlling tactical actions, observation, and adjusting artillery fire.



OH-6 “Loach”

Watch the tremendous low-level, high-speed maneuvering of our Vietnam combat-experienced Scout helicopter as it searches out the elusive “enemy”.



A fast-reaction infantry “Blue Team”

VIETNAM SCENARIO:

Sunrise on a typical day in the Central Highlands of South Vietnam. A lone L-19 “Bird Dog” spotter aircraft is suddenly hit by enemy groundfire, forcing it to make an emergency landing in hostile territory. An OV-10 “Mohawk” returning from an early morning reconnaissance mission is quickly contacted by the downed spotter pilot. Watch the combat action as the various elements of the rescue team arrive, led by the speedy and maneuverable OH-6 “Loach” scout helicopter and the deadly AH-1 “Cobra” gunship. Witness the venerable UH-1 “Huey” helicopters as they fly into the combat zone and insert a fast-reaction infantry team to secure the area and rescue the downed airman.



UH-1 “Huey”

The icon of the Vietnam war the “Huey” performs multiple missions including air assault, search and rescue, resupply, and medevac



AH-1 “Cobra” Gunship

Observe the power and agility of the first helicopter built solely for attack missions, heavily armed with guns and rockets, as it searches out and destroys the “enemy”.
